## 3. Three New Books Received.

The following works were acquired by us from the Pomeranz Book Store in Jerusalem.

All three of them appear to contain information of possible value to us.

We will read the works and probably write short, or longer, reviews of each one.

(a) Jonathan Emmanuel, "Britain, the Bible, and Balfour. Mandate for a Jewish state, 1530- 1917," ca. 420 pages, UK, 2009.

Analyzes how the English from the time of Henry-viii (1500s) elevated the authority of the Old Testament and repeatedly inclined to help the Jews return to the Holy Land and set up their own Kingdom there.

(b) Tamar Weissman, "Tribal Lands. The Twelve Tribes of Israel in their Ancestral Territories," ca. 350 pages, Jerusalem, 2019. hardcover, illustrated.

Examines Israelite Tribal Territories with their geographies and archaeological findings, alongside Biblical Heroes according to the Bible and Midrashim, etc, who were in those areas and deduces Tribal Character.

(c) Nechama Price, "Tribal Blueprints. Twelve Brothers and

the Destiny of Israel," ca. 289 pages, Jerusalem, 2020.  
hardcover.

The authoress analyses each of the individual Tribes and Tribal heroes giving her own opinion in the light of Classical Rabbinical Commentaries.

#### 5. The Return of the Ten Tribes

Outline for Article in Preparation.

The Sources indicate:

Judah will precede Joseph into the Land of Israel (Micah 4: 8) .

Judah will be initially loathe to recognize Joseph since Judah

was alone in its time of exile and persecution (Isaiah 49: 21). Judah will be preparing the way for the rest of the Tribes (Hosea 6: 11 see the Brit-Am Commentary) .

At first Joseph will return to Gilead (Syria and Jordan) and Lebanon (Zechariah 10: 10).

At first the Lost Tribes will return to Bashan (Syria and Iraq) and Gilead (Syria and Jordan) see Micah 7: 14.

Jeremiah calls upon Ephraim in Exile to study proofs (such as the historical pathway of "Megalithic" Monuments) of its paths of Exile in order to know the way to come back to its cities in Samaria (Jeremiah 31: 19-20).

Eventually the Land of Israel will divided up amongst the Tribes of Israel with a special portion set aside for the Levites, the Temple, and the Ruler (Ezekiel chapter 48) with the non-Israelite stranger who dwells amongst us and identifies with us receiving a portion in whatsoever tribe he is attached to (Ezekiel 47: 22).

The Lost Tribes will also keep the Lands they presently dwell in. These will become part of the Land of Israel, of the Holy Land.

The Lost Tribes when they return may still partly be pagans and be accepted through repentance afterwards. This possibility is consistent with the return at first coming from east of the Jordan.

The Lost Tribes when they return may emerge from the region of Kurdistan at present under de facto control of the USA and UK.

Jacob (aka Israel) Kept the Law of Tithing: Jacob linked his tithing to a Return to the House of his Father. We can do the same.

20 Then Jacob made a vow, saying, If God will be with me and will watch over me on this journey I am taking and will give me food to eat and clothes to wear

21 so that I return safely to my fathers household, then the LORD will be my God

22 and this stone that I have set up as a pillar will be Gods House, and of all that you give me I will give you a tenth.

Malachi 3:

10 Bring all the tithes into the storehouse,  
That there may be food in My house,  
And try Me now in this,  
Says the LORD of hosts,  
'If I will not open for you the windows of heaven  
And pour out for you such blessing  
That there will not be room enough to receive it.

and your vats will burst open with new wine.
